- o Tuition is **non-refundable** for any missed or cancelled lessons/classes.
- o Tuition needs to be paid monthly and is due by the FIRST date each month.
- You'll receive a monthly invoice with how many lessons. You can choose to pay online via Zelle or with cash or check. Please write your student's name in the memo line.
- Sibling Discount is available for group class. 1st enrolled student is billed at the full rate,
 2nd Sibling receives a 10% discount.

• Scheduling and absences:

- o Our Private Lessons and group classes will occur weekly
- If you need to reschedule the lesson, please contact us at least 24 hours in advance.
 We'll try our best to reschedule for you. If the lessons need to be cancelled due to teacher's ill, Make-up lesson is guaranteed.
- Group classes are subject to cancellation if enrollment is below prescribed minimums 2. Tuition will be credited and roll into next month if the class is cancelled due to the low enrollment.

Class Descriptions

30 mins Private lesson

The goal of this 30-minute voice lesson is to introduce student to fundamental vocal techniques, helping student develop a healthy and sustainable singing voice. We'll cover posture, breath control, vocal exercises, and basic warm-ups. The practice repertoire generally includes musical theater, arias, Italian and German art songs, etc. A suitable vocal plan is designed based on the student's vocal condition, helping the student build a foundation of vocal technique while strengthening stage performance skills.

45mins Private Lesson

In the 45-minute lesson, sight-singing and music theory will be added on top of the 30-minute lesson, enhancing the student's ability to read music. In terms of repertoire study, stage movement and performance training will be incorporated. This will help students integrate music and performance on stage, reinforcing their foundational musical knowledge while utilizing performance techniques.

Group Class

The 45-minute group class will focus on training students in vocal techniques, including breath control, warm-up exercises, stage performance, sight-singing, and music theory/history. Selected choral pieces and musical theater excerpts will be rehearsed, with students taking on different roles and collaborating on solo, duet, and a cappella performances. Through this collaborative approach, students will enhance their vocal skills while developing confidence in their stage presence.
